Cliffleball Wiffleball Bat Modification Specifications and Regulations

Allowed Bat:

- Only the standard yellow plastic Wiffleball bats are permitted for use in the tournament.

Grip Modifications:

- No Restrictions: Players are free to modify the bat's grip using any materials or methods they choose. This includes:
 - Tape (e.g., electrical, athletic, or duct tape)
 - Baseball bat grips or any commercially available bat grip wraps
 - Any other material or style for personal preference

Internal Modifications:

- Players may modify the inside of the bat by adding any materials that do not violate the following restriction:
 - Restriction: No hard objects or metallic substances are allowed inside the bat.

Exterior Barrel Modifications:

- Allowed Exterior Modifications: Players may modify the bat's barrel to enhance performance or weight balance by adding soft, flexible materials such as:
 - Bike tubing or similar rubber materials
 - Additional plastic (as long as the material is non-metallic and flexible)
- Restrictions:
 - Modifications must not affect the bat's length or weight beyond specified limits (see length and weight specifications below).



- No sharp objects, metal, or hard substances can be added to the exterior of the bat.

Bat Length and Weight Limits:

- Length Extension: Players are allowed to extend the length of their bat by combining two yellow plastic Wiffle Ball bats. The total length extension may not exceed 4 inches.
- Maximum Length: The bat, after modifications, must not exceed 38 inches in total length (34-inch standard + up to 4-inch extension).
- Maximum Weight: The bat, after modifications, must not exceed 10 ounces in total weight.

Prohibited Modifications:

- No modifications involving metal, glass, or sharp materials are allowed inside or outside the bat.
- No substances that alter the surface to provide excessive grip on the ball (e.g., pine tar or adhesives).
- Modifications that intentionally change the shape of the bat beyond its original cylindrical form are not allowed.

Inspection and Compliance:

- All modified bats must be inspected by tournament officials prior to use in the tournament.
- Bats that do not meet the length, weight, or material restrictions will be disqualified from play.
- Players found using non-compliant bats during gameplay will face penalties, including disqualification from the game.
